

Promotion Requirements

Students must have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average (GPA) during their 7th & 8th grade years. In addition, 8th grade students must also pass all core subjects (Math, Science, History & Language Arts) in final reporting period in order to be eligible to participate in 8th grade Promotion Activities. Students must also meet conduct and attendance requirements during their 8th grade year. (See Board Policy AR 5123 & 5127)

Requisitos para la Promoción

Además los estudiantes del octavo grado tienen que pasar las siguientes clases: Matemáticas, Ciencia, Historia, y Artes de lenguaje para que puedan participar en la ceremonia y las actividades de promoción del grado 8. HONOR ROLL	<p>Principal's Honor Roll Students are presented with a certificate and recognition at an awards program held at the end of each trimester. The criteria for Principal's Honor Roll:</p> <p>Grades 6, 7, & 8 4.0 in all subjects. Grades 2 - 5 5's in Math and English Language Arts standards. A letter grade of A in all other subjects.</p> <p>Honor Roll Students are presented with a certificate and recognition at the trimester awards assembly. The criteria for Honor Roll:</p> <p>Grades 6, 7, & 8 A grade point average from 3.0 to 3.99 in all subjects. No F's in any subject. Grades 2 - 5 4's and 5's in Math and English Language Arts standards. A letter grade of A or B in all other subjects.</p>
AWARDS	<p>Academy Character & Excellence Award This award is presented two times a year. Each teacher nominates students who have demonstrated good citizenship, exemplary effort and model behavior. Finalists are recognized at an awards dinner.</p> <p>Sanger Academy Bear Award This award is given to students who have demonstrated outstanding citizenship, excellent character and academic progress.</p> <p>Reading /Mathematics / Writing Award Students who have exhibited exemplary effort and/or outstanding progress in these curricular areas are recognized at awards assemblies.</p> <p>Attendance Award Students who are not absent or tardy at the end of each trimester are eligible for this award.</p> <p>Co-Curricular Awards Students who participate in co-curricular activities will be recognized for their efforts.</p> <p>Banners Students or teams who excel at the district, county or state level will be recognized with a banner.</p>
